Business case:

The Early Childhood Education Workforce Registry will fill a gap in Kansas's current Mixed Delivery System (Kansas is part of a minority of states that do not own and use an ECE Workforce Registry solution). The following benefits are anticipated from fully standing up the anticipated environment:1. The Early Childhood Workforce (daycare providers, professional development providers, after care program staff, those studying early childhood in higher ed) will have a virtual environment to connect, which can impact retention and advancement their field. Savings may be found from decreased turnover.

- 2. With the QRIS module now fully built out (subproject 1, and part of the scope of the overall, initial effort) quality improvement efforts of the field are more easily tracked, identified, and monitored, leading to decreased administrative capacity needed to carry out those tasks, and an ultimate increase in quality improvements.
- 3. Integrating multiple systems into one location will save capacity for data collection and streamline a currently disparate group of systems serving the same group of people.
